

New York State Department of Health has lifted the restrictions on who is eligible to receive the H1N1 vaccine. As of December 10, 2009, everyone over the age of 6 months is now eligible to receive the vaccine. Nassau County Department of Health has partnered with the North Shore-LIJ Health System and Nassau University Medical Center to provide the H1N1 (Swine Flu) vaccine at no cost. **Appointments are not needed.** The vaccine will be available at the following locations to all residents over the age of 6 months:
